Are repairs & an after-sales service available on site?

Reputation

Is it an existing company or new to the market? Are there references and reports of experience?

Communication

Is there a contact person who is available on site or by phone?

8 

Spare parts & final costing

How can I order a missing part at short notice? Will the product still be available in a few years, or will the entire fleet have to be replaced?

10 

Production

Which international standards are used for production? Are specifications for energy-saving and climate-friendly production complied with?
